

Pastoral Search Process Update

Beginning the end of January 2021, two "Critical Questions" related to pastoral needs and expectations for our congregation were distributed each week. These questions were designed to give members an opportunity to assist the Session in moving forward with a search for a pastor. The Session reviewed the responses as well as considered the reality of membership numbers and financial health, with the following results:

- *Half time pastor (20-25 hours/week) is what our finances will currently support. It was unanimous that <u>pastoral care</u> was top priority, with <u>preaching/teaching</u> being second, and <u>church growth</u> third.
- *Over and over we heard appreciation for the unique "family" our church is; we are a welcoming church; how people care for each other; how we are a neutral forum for differing views; that we are an older congregation united in fellowship.
- *To prosper, we should recruit more families with children; program for a variety of ages; provide worship experiences that attract all ages; continue to emphasize fellowship and activities that care for needs of others; encourage all members to be involved in whatever way possible.
- *Options currently being pursued for pastoral leadership: ideal, <u>but very</u> unlikely a retired, part-time pastor; joint ministry with near by churches, i.e.: Dawson/Appleton, Slayton, Marshall.
- *Change realities: likely need to change mindset of having a solo pastor; sharing a pastor will mean possible different times and format for worship; pastor not in pulpit each week but alternative worship using technology; in emergency situations, pastor may not be readily available; expecting 20-25 hours per week for a pastor may not be workable.



Despair



Session Synopsis-July 21, 2021

*Treasurer's Report-

Income more than expenses for June 2021 was \$860.48. Year to Date income was less than expenses by a minus \$679.38.

\$100 was paid for mowing at the church.

\$180 was paid for tuning the pianos.

\$50 was paid for mowing at the manse.

\$120 was paid for snow blowing at the manse.

There were no other unusual expenses.

*Clerk's Report-

Action was taken to approve ordering three Presbyterian Calendars. The need for assistance to do Homebound Communion was raised. It was agreed the hold on the Preparedness Plan continue. Karen Houtman was appointed Commissioner to the Presbytery Meeting in Mankato on August 17.

*Christian Education/Outreach-

On Sunday, August 1, Bibles will be given to six of our young people and the five young people attending camp August 1-7 will be recognized. Sunday School will resume on August 12. Confirmation will begin on Wednesday, September 15. The date of December 19 was set for the Sunday School Christmas program.

*Deacon-

At the July 14 meeting, plans were made for future Deacon meetings, Communion dates and preparation, and bulletin delivery August through October. Homebound Communion was discussed and plans to continue were made.

*Finance/Property-

It is anticipated that the sale of the manse will be posted online with Keating Realty next week.

*Worship/Hospitality-

Plans for continued Fellowship Time following worship were discussed. It was noted that the camera used to record Worship Services needs to be replaced- efforts are underway to do that. In the meantime, we are attempting to live stream the services. It was noted that Marge Frazeur has offered to do pulpit supply for July 24, as well as August 1st and 8th.

*Old Business-

A discussion and review was held regarding the Session's meeting with the Dawson and Appleton congregations on Tuesday, July 20th. A possible joint ministry with those congregations is being considered as one of the options for future pastoral leadership.
